**HON'BLE MR. JUSTICE SUDESH BANSAL**

**Order**

**21/05/2026**

1. Feeling aggrieved by the prolonged suspension of petitioner (R.A.S Officer) posted as Sub-Divisional Officer, Bandikui w.e.f. 15.01.2021, instant writ petition has been filed on 15.12.2025.
2. It has been pointed out that petitioner and one Pushkar Kumar Mittal, who was posted as Sub-Divisional Officer, Dausa, were booked in FIR No.17/2021, registered for offences under Section 7 of the Prevention of Corruption (Amendment) Act, 2018 read with Section 120-B of IPC and on account of their arrest in this FIR, both were placed under suspension vide two separate orders of even date i.e. 15.01.2021.





3. It has been pointed out that suspension order of Pushkar Kumar Mittal has been stayed by this Court vide order dated 17.07.2025 passed in S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.10634/2025, but the suspension of petitioner is continuing and even the departmental charge-sheet has not been served upon the petitioner, although in the FIR No.17/2021, charge-sheet has been filed and prosecution sanction has already been accorded, but there is no further progress in the criminal trial, hence in that view, prayer has been made to revoke the suspension of petitioner.

4. Additional Government Counsel appearing on behalf of respondents pointed out that after filing of this writ petition, departmental charge-sheet to petitioner so also to Pushkar Kumar Mittal for the *pari materia* charges, have been served on 30.12.2025. As far as revocation of suspension of petitioner is concerned, same was reviewed by the Committee and in the last meeting of Review Committee dated 16.12.2025, recommendations for revocation of suspension of petitioner was not made. Although, he submits that subsequent thereto, meeting of Review Committee has convened on 12.05.2026, but he is not aware about the minutes of meeting.

5. Be that as it may, at this stage, the case of petitioner is not differentiable than the delinquent-employee Pushkar Kumar Mittal whose suspension has already been stayed by this Court vide order dated 17.07.2025 following the dictum of the Hon'ble Supreme Court expounded in case of **Ajay Kumar Choudhary Vs. Union of India & Anr.:[(2015) 7 SCC 291]**. Further, in the minutes of Review Committee dated 16.12.2025, no reasons have





been assigned for not revoking the suspension of petitioner, who is in continuous suspension since 15.01.2021 and the departmental charge-sheet has been served upon the petitioner on 30.12.2025, therefore, in order to maintain the parity, the suspension order of petitioner dated 15.01.2021, is hereby stayed.

6. Let the writ petition be listed for final disposal/ hearing along with S.B. Civil Writ Petition No.10634/2025. Both the parties may complete the pleadings and may file additional documents, if so desire.
